Princeton "Dakota" 6300 #6, #8

oil paints: ( I like Rembrandt and Gamblin but whatever you like is fine )

Titanium White

Titanium Buff

Ultramarine Blue

Cerulean Blue

Sap Green

Alizarin Crimson

Cad Red Light

Yellow Ochre

Transparent Red Iron Oxide (Rembrandt)

Cad Yellow light

\*Optional: I keep these on my palette because these are useful and beautiful.

Windsor Newton Green Gold

Cobalt Blue

King's Blue

Terra Rosa

Gamblin Radiant Lemon

minimum of 6 panels ranging in size from 8x10 to 11x14
